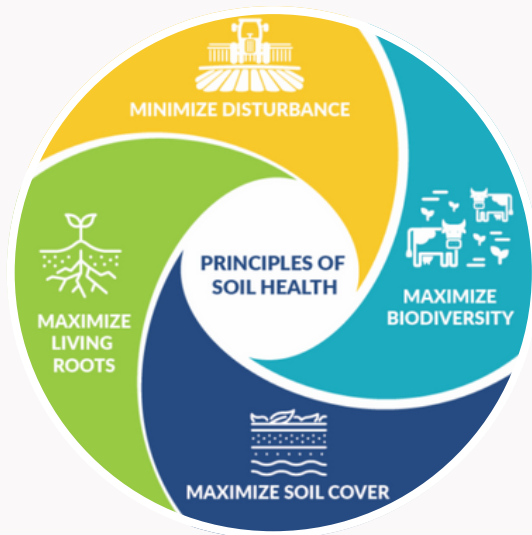


Winter Clinic Soil Health 101
